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Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation Limited, a Joint Venture of Government of India and Government of Karnataka, is a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) entrusted with the responsibility of implementing the Metro Rail Project in the city of Bangalore.

BMRCL has embarked upon the journey of improving urban mobility in a wholesome manner with comprehensive improvement. For this goal, it has been determined that a multi-disciplinary team is required to steer BMRCL's many undertakings related to development and planning around metro infrastructure towards an integrated mobility ecosystem. Planning for Transit Oriented Development, Multi-modal Integration, and Last mile connectivity prioritising pedestrianisation, PT and NMV modes are some of the ways in BMRCL intends to achieve this. Also, various sustainable urban transport projects have been taken up by BMRCL wherein the consultant will be required to ensure highest quality and consistency across all deliverables of the project. The consultant will also be required to demonstrate experience of handling complex urban transport solutions for efficient implementation of projects.

Further, BMRCL is also in the process of developing integrated and sustainable mobility solutions in Bengaluru through Technical Assistance from ADB. As a part of this, the consultant will be required to manage and coordinate with the external agency and should have the expertise to develop holistic planning processes.

POSITION: JUNIOR TRANSPORT PLANNER (CONSULTANT)

- Experience of working on city level transport projects like planning for Multi-modal Integration, Last mile connectivity prioritising pedestrianisation, PT and NMV etc., is essential
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office suite, specifically Excel and PowerPoint; knowledge of AutoCAD and GIS is required; Knowledge in SPSS or other statistical analysis software will be an advantage
- Strong ability to employ qualitative and quantitative analysis is essential. Should have adequate understanding of the other travel demand modelling/microscopic simulation and other transportation modelling software
- Should be able to plan and administer data collection activities like traffic counts, opinion surveys, house hold surveys, O-D surveys, etc. necessary for urban transport projects.
- Experience in working with public sector organizations and government agencies is desirable
- Ability to present technical information in a clear and concise manner (Reports/ presentations) with good written and spoken English skills
- Proficiency in Kannada is desirable

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To evaluate current plans and carry out new feasibility studies for first and last mile connectivity and multi-modal integration options for BMRCL.

- Experience of working on city level transport projects like planning for Multi-modal Integration, Last mile connectivity prioritising pedestrianisation, PT and NMV etc.,
- Good knowledge of Micro simulation/statistical software or other modelling software relevant to transportation planning
- Should be able to oversee and analyse the traffic and transportation related datasets
- Ability to present technical information in a clear and concise manner (Reports/ presentations) with good written and spoken English skills is must
- Ability to self-manage and meet deadlines
- Proficiency in Kannada is desirable

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Develop work-plan for sustainable connectivity options
- Coordinate with DULT and Design Unit of BMRCL for planning of new station layouts and improvement of existing stations and surrounding areas to facilitate multi-modal mobility options
- Should be able to assess and analyse complex transportation related challenges
- Undertake assessment of Multi modal integration plans with associated infrastructural facilities, geometric design etc.,
- Liaise with other departments within BMRCL and with DULT and other public agencies and government bodies at the city level
- Develop strategies for sustainable connectivity options from perspectives of commuters and service providers
- Undertake, manage and facilitate stakeholder engagements on wide range of issues and topics
